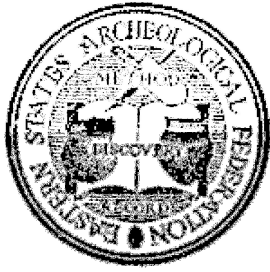

Individuals are invited to submit abstracts for papers, posters, and workshops on topics related to archaeology in the Eastern United States to be presented at the 80th Annual Eastern States Archaeological Federation (ESAF) held Thursday, October 31 through Sunday, November 3, 2013. Thematic sessions, such as prehistoric or historic archaeological topics focused on the Gulf of Maine, are especially welcomed. Comparing or contrasting the archaeology of the Gulf of Maine with other areas of Eastern North America, or maritime cultures around the North Atlantic might also be good thematic session topics.

Guidelines:

1. Presenter(s) must be individual members of ESAF for 2013.
2. Registration fees and membership dues for ALL presenters are due by **August 31, 2013**. Membership dues and conference registration may be paid via PayPal at www.esaf-archeology.org. or by mail to The Maine Archaeological Society, P. O. Box 982, Augusta, ME 04332. Abstracts will not be accepted until fees are paid.
3. An individual can be the primary author on only **one** paper or poster, but may be a co-author on other papers or posters. Workshop participants may also present papers.

Submission Information:

The deadline for the paper or poster title, abstract, and fees is **August 31, 2013**. In addition to the title and abstract (150 words or fewer), provide name, affiliation, address, phone, and email address for each presenter. Please include audio-visual requirements (e.g. Powerpoint). Thematic session chairs should submit all paper and poster abstracts as a package, but please contact Program Chair with thematic session topic to discuss in advance. Please send submissions to ESAF Program Chair as an email or email attachment with "ESAF 2013" in subject line.
